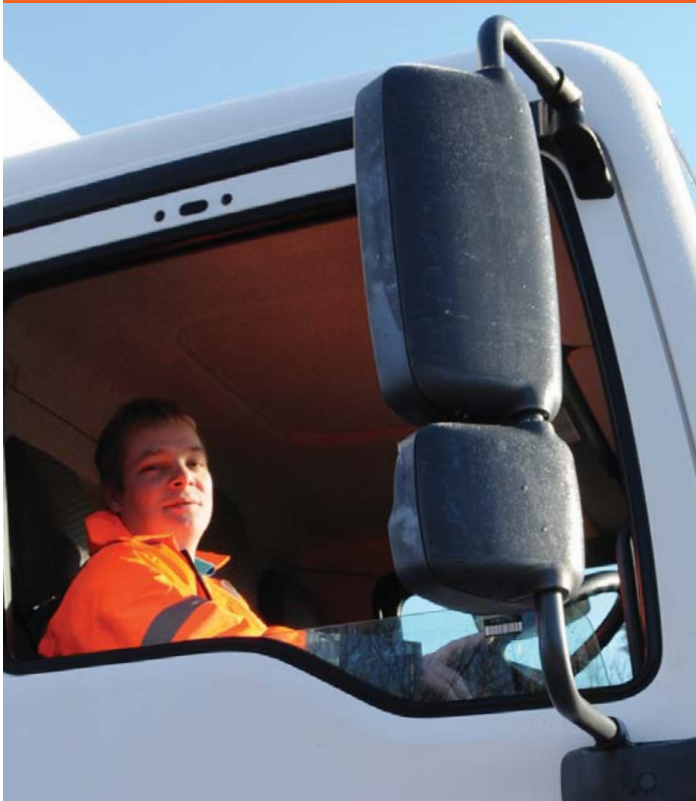


# ADR Certificate

“Accord European Relatif au Transport International des Marchandises Dangereuses par Route”  
(The carriage of dangerous goods via road transport)



## The Course:

ADR is the carriage of potentially hazardous goods via road transport.

Professional drivers are required by law to hold a Vocational Training Certificate in order to transport dangerous goods.

## Outcome:

On successful completion candidates will receive their ADR licence directly from the DVLA.

## Benefits to employer and employee:
