Transport Manager's Qualification



The course

The Certificate of Professional Competence in Road Haulage is a level 3 qualification that gives the learner the skill set to become a fully qualified transport manager. It teaches best practice in transport operations as well as giving the learner a detailed knowledge of the rules and regulations applicable to road haulage in the UK and Europe.

From 2012 there is only one qualification that covers both national and international operations. Anyone who has passed the previous National CPC and wants to upgrade to International will have until December 2012 to pass the International module. Anyone who has previously passed some but not all of the National CPC modules will have to sit the new combined examination.

The 12-day Mantra Road Haulage CPC course has been specially developed to give learners the knowledge and support to pass the examinations and achieve the OCR qualification.

Outcomes

On successful completion learners will receive a Certificate of Professional Competence. This means that they can now apply for a Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence.

Benefits to employer and employee

Learners will develop their knowledge of road haulage laws, finance and road safety, helping to ensure a safe practice.

Employers will be complying with the Goods Vehicle Operators' Regulations 1997, as well as improving the professionalism and performance of their business.

Examination

The new CPC in Road Haulage consists of a single multiple choice assessment and a single case study assessment. Both elements will test national and international knowledge/application. So, to achieve a new International CPC, candidates will only need to take two units.

Examinations take place four times a year in March, June, September and December.

The deadline for registering to sit the examination is usually three weeks prior to the examination date.

Who is it for?

Road Haulage CPC is for individuals who want to enter the profession of transport manager or to demonstrate their professional competence to meet operator licensing requirements – holding a CPC is mandatory to get an 'O' License.

Learners can progress to a range of other qualifications and short courses.
