

LGV Driver Assessment



Class C and C+E drivers could benefit from an objective assessment of their driving skills, particularly with regards to fuel efficiency and heavy driving style that could lead to excessive wear and tear.

The driver assessment is designed to benchmark fuel efficiency and identify any poor driving behaviour that could lead to excessive vehicle wear and tear, or might lead to an accident.

The driver and their employer will receive a written assessment report containing observations on driving style, together with any recommendations for corrective training.

The driver will be assessed against the following criteria;

- fuel consumption
- safe handling and defensive driving
- minimising wear and tear
- hazard perception
- daily walk around checks
- road sense and lane discipline
- manoeuvring
- observing speed limits and traffic regulations
