WEBSITE COOKIE POLICY

A) INTRODUCTION

This policy should be read in conjunction with our Privacy Notice.

When you visit our website we collect information about your computer/device, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type. This gives us statistical data about users' browsing actions and patterns, this does not identify any individual. It is used to inform improvements to the website, system administration, and to report aggregate information to third parties.

If your computer/device is set to accept cookies we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the storage drive of your computer. We use this information to track the pages you visit, to find out how the website is being used and to assess its ease of use. Personal information about you is not collected during the tracking process.

B) THIRD PARTY

We use a third party product called Google Analytics, which is a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. (Google), to help us to analyse how our website is used. In doing so information about your use of our website, including your IP address, may be transmitted to, and stored by, Google. This information will be subject to Google's Privacy Policy.

Google Analytics uses cookies to define user sessions, as well as to provide a number of key features in the Google Analytics reports. Google Analytics sets or updates cookies only to collect data required for the reports. Additionally, Google Analytics uses only first-party cookies. This means that all cookies set by Google Analytics for our website send data only to the servers for our website. This effectively makes Google Analytics cookies the personal property of our website, and the data cannot be altered or retrieved by any service on another website or domain.

Videos shown on our website are hosted by YouTube.com and are subject to YouTube.com Privacy Policy.

Other cookies may be stored to your computer hard drive by external vendors when this website uses referral programs, sponsored links or adverts. Such cookies are used for conversion and referral tracking and typically expire after 30 days, though some may take longer. No personal information is stored, saved or collected.

C) REFUSAL OF COOKIES

You can do this by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of the website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our website.
