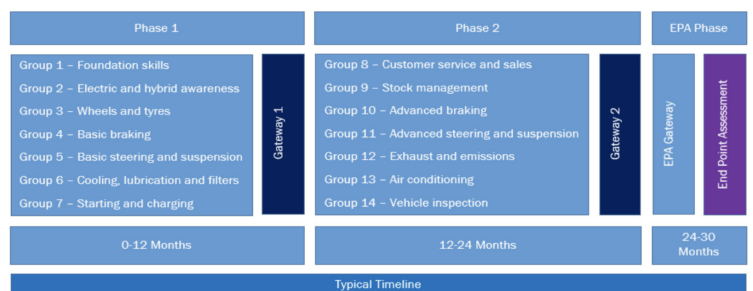

- compile evidence of tasks completed in the workplace
- undertake assessments and gateway test
- complete and End Point Assessment
